OUTSTANDING HUMAN SERVICE STUDENT AWARD PROCESS

1. Nomination Process

a. Call for Nominations

- The NCOHS Executive Board will notify the Human Services Community College faculty of the award and call for nominations to be generated and sent to the selection committee post marked on or before October 11, 2019 (nominations received after this date will not be considered).

b. Who can nominate

- Faculty members from each Community College nominate students whose qualities they characterize as outstanding. Faculty may nominate no more than two (2) students.
- No self-nominations will be accepted.

c. Who is eligible

- Individuals must be Human Services Technology majors (degree, diploma, certificate) who has earned a minimum of 12 credit hours under the human services curriculum (excluding general education courses)

d. Informed Nominations

- Nominators are also encouraged to supply support materials with the completed nomination form.

e. Support materials (Evidence supporting your nomination must be included)

- Completed nomination form (provided by the nominator).
- Transcript (unofficial transcript will be accepted with nominator's verification)
- Academic achievements and honors.
- Community Service
- Extra-curricular activities.
- Leadership experience.

2. Selection Process

a. Review of Nominations

- Each application will be assigned a random number by the selection committee chair before full selection committee review.

b. Selection Committees

- A selection committee will be established to review applications. Selection committees will be composed of non-human service faculty and staff.

c. Evaluation Criteria

- An Outstanding Student Achievement Award recipient should be a well-rounded and successful member of his or her campus and community. Tie-breaking areas of selection could include GPA, leadership activities and community service.

3. Recognition

The Two Outstanding Student Award recipients will be honored at the NCOHS annual conference.

- Award recipients will be presented a medallion (or plaque) and will give a short acceptance speech. The Outstanding Student recipients will also be awarded a \$450 scholarship that can be used for the following:
 - Tuition, books and/or school related fees for the Spring semester.
 - If the winner is in their final semester and will not have tuition expenses for the spring semester then the scholarship can be used for the next year's SOHS conference.

- Or if the recipient plans to pursue their bachelor during the next year's fall semester, the scholarship can be used for tuition, books and fees for their bachelor degree.
 - The recipient will let the NCOHS Treasurer know which option above they would prefer to use their \$450 scholarship for.
- All nominees will be acknowledged as well.
